

NOVEMBER 18, 1863

Page 2:2 - DEATH OF JOHN NEW - Mr. John NEW, a well-known printer, and at one time editor and proprietor of the Daily Union, died in Albany City yesterday, of congestion of the lungs. His age was 42 years.

Page 2:3 - DROWNED - A man named Francis FARRELL, about 50 years of age, was drowned in the Canal, a short distance north of the Canal St. Bridge. It is thought that he accidentally walked into the water. He was discovered struggling in the water by a boatman who gave the alarm, and efforts were made to rescue him but in vain. - Coroner BRENNAN held an inquest and the jury returned a verdict of accidental drowning.

Page 2:6 - DIED - In Troy November 13, Abbie Ella, youngest child of Charles & Marietta HAYNER of this Village, age 3 years, 11 months & 11 days.

NOVEMBER 25, 1863

Page 2:3 - Rev. George W. HATHAWAY, late Pastor of Trinity Church in this Village, died of chronic diarrhea, on the 15th inst near Boston, Mass. Rev. Mr. H. was quite advanced in years - having spent nearly half a century in the ministry. The Good Shepherd has called him home - and he has gone to reap the rich reward of his consistent piety and faithfulness during his earthly pilgrimage.

DECEMBER 2, 1863

Page 2:2 - Charles PHILLIPS, a well-known sporting character, and keeper of a hotel on the Albany and Schenectady Turnpike, was killed in the bar room of the Delevan House, on Monday evening - One Matthew BRUMAGHEN shooting him through the heart. It is asserted that the deceased was the aggressor in the affray, which terminated thus fatally.

Page 2:5 - MARRIED - November 26th by Rev. W.R. BROWN, of this Village, Edmund B. MARTIN & Mary A. HITCHCOCK, all of Troy.

- At Troy, November 25<sup>th</sup> 1863 by Rev. Dr. TUCKER, Mr. William H. LEWIS & Miss Teresa GREEN, both of that City.

- In this Village November 13th by Rev. G.L. ROOF, Mr. George MOFFAT & Miss Ellen McCLARAN both of this place.

- In this Village on the 1st inst., by William HOLLANDS, Justice of the Peace, Samuel HART of Egypt, Monroe County & Mary TICE of Buffalo, N.Y.

DIED - In Sparta Wisconsin, November 25th of diptheria, Eddy, youngest son of Sullivan P. & H.A. GREENMAN, formerly of this Village, age 7 years & 5 mos.
