Page 2:6 - DIED - In Union Village, Washington Co. NY on the 22d inst., Mrs. Margaret BLAKELY, mother of Billings BLAKELY formerly of this Village (aged 85 years)

- In Cleveland, Oswego Co., NY on the 18th inst. Edwin TALLCOTT, brother of D.W. TALLCOTT, of this Village, age 48 years.

- In this Village on the 27th inst. Hannah A. CASEY, age 25 years & 7 months.

JANUARY 7, 1864

Page 2:2 - Capt. James Y. ACKLEY, an old resident of this Village, and a river navigator since a boy, fell dead while engaged in shaving himself on Sunday morning last. Coroner BRENNAN summoned a jury and held an inquest;- A verdict of death from hemorrhage of the lungs being rendered.

Page 2:4- Hon. Henry HUBBARD, for 42 years a resident of Pittsfield, Mass. died at that place last Friday, aged 80 years. He was for many years a prominent member of the Berkshire County Bar and at one time conducted the Berkshire County Whig. He was repeatedly a member of the Mass. Legislature.

Page 2:6 - MARRIED - On the 22d ult by Rev. C.S. MEAD, Levenius A. TYLER of this Village and Miss Louisa M. HENDRICK of Ballston Spa.

DIED - In this Village on the 29th ult, Ellen LAMBERT, age 37 years.

Page 2:4 - A notice about two sisters, twins, aged 52 years named Maria & Marina TUTTLE of Utica NY who lost their way from their residence near the Cemetery and one of them froze to death namely Maria TUTTLE. (from the Utica Observer)

MARRIED - ^{In Philadelphia} On the 14th inst by Rev. J. Wheaton SMITH, J. Russell COLEMAN of this Village and Jennie E., ^{eldest} daughter of Samuel P. BAILEY of the former place.

DIED - In this Village on the 17th inst. of diptheria, Jessie eldest daughter of Alexander & _____ MCLELLAN in the 8th year of her age.

- In this Village on the 18th inst. Samuel, youngest son of Samuel D. & Ellen CARTHY in the 2d year of his age.
