Page 2:3 - A woman named SULLIVAN, aged about 60 years, residing in this Village, was found dead in the basin, at the foot of Union St., on Tuesday evening of last week. Coroner BRENNAN held an inquest but the jury were unable to determine whether her death was accidental or otherwise.

Page 2:4 - THE BARRACKS SHOOTING AFFAIR - The body of William FARRELL, who was shot at the Barracks Saturday night was not sent off as reported. He is still at the dead house of that institution awaiting identification. His relatives are requested to call, identify the body and receive the money found on his person. Although the deceased enlisted under this name, and said he belonged to Mechanicville, Saratoga Co., it is believed that name and residence are fictitious, he having adopted these to suit his purposes, as was the custom among bounty jumpers. If this is so, he may never be known.

Page 2:3 - DEAD - Jas. H. BRISBIN, formerly a prominent lawyer and resident of this Village, died at Schuylerville on Sunday last.
