Page 2:3 - MARRIED - On the 1st inst. at St. John's Church, Detroit Mich. by Rev. W.E. ARMITAGE, Charles D. ROUSSEAU of this Village & Addie L. youngest daughter of John S. BULKLEY Esq. of the former place.

- On the 1st inst at St. John's Church Troy by Rev. H.C. POTTER, Charles H. ROGERS of this Village and Mary A. LASELLE of the former place.

- In this Village on the 7th inst., by Rev. H.V. JONES, Henry C. KELSEY & Mary L. SMITH, both of this place.

DIED - At Fairfield, Lenawee County, Mich. on the 21st day of May 1864, Rigden FOX, age 58 yrs & 1 month.

- In this Village June 4th Clarissa W. BROWN, wife of Daniel F. FREE, age 44 years, 5 months & 16 days.

Page 3:1 - We regret to learn that the wounds sustained by Lt. William ORR, of the 7th Artillery has proved fatal. The manner in which he received the wound which resulted in his death is as follows: "After breakfast one morning, he strolled from his companions a short distance into the woods, and was there struck by a ball from a Rebel sharpshooter. Dr. POMFRET, Surgeon of the Regiment, pronounced the wound fatal when he abstracted the ball. Lt. ORR had quite a number of friends and acquaintances in this Village."

Page 3:2 - INQUEST - On Saturday morning Coroner BRENNAN held an inquest on the body of Mrs. BASSETT, an English lady residing in the lower part of the Village. She had been ailing for sometime, but was walking about the Village Friday morning. She died in the afternoon. The verdict of the jury was death from inflammation of the bowels.

JUNE 15, 1864

Page 2:1 - RAILROAD ACCIDENT - Two gravel cars collided on the Central road near Cohoes last Wednesday evening. One man named FITZJEROLD was killed. He resided at Cohoes.

2. THE REMAINS OF COL. MORRIS - The remains of Col. Lewis O. MORRIS of the 7th Regiment, arrived in Albany Thursday last. The funeral took place from the residence of his brother-in-law Dr. VANDERPOOL Friday afternoon.

KILLED - Lt. Thos. J. MCCLURE of this Village, of Battery L. 7th Heavy Artillery, was killed at the Battle of Cold Harbor, Virginia on the 3d inst.
