Page 3:2 - DROWNED - Last Wednesday night about 11 o'clock a man named George TALMAN deck hand on the boat WILLIAM PALMER of Ticonderoga, while climbing up the gate of Lock No. 1 on the Champlain Canal, near the old junction, missed his footing and fell into the lock, and was drowned. A search was made and the body was recovered in about an hour. The next morning, Coroner BRENNAN of this Village, held an inquest and the jury returned a verdict of accidental drowning. The deceased was about 22 years old, unmarried and belonged to Moore's Junction, Clinton County.

Page 2:4 - A disturbance on the horse cars - As the conductor on the 10 o'clock down train, on Monday night, was collecting fares, an Irish woman refused to pay, stating that she had paid her fare to Albany at the time of crossing the ferry. The conductor stopped the car, and allowed that she must pay or get off. She refused to do either, and when force was used to eject her, fought valiantly. She was finally got off however, with the assistance of the driver.

Page 3:1 - BOUNTY JUMPERS - Also on Saturday evening a squad of recruits were sent off <sup>from the Barracks,</sup> among the number was a man named Michael WATERS, alias MCGOWAN, who is an alledged notorious bounty jumper. On Sunday afternoon shortly after the arrival of the recruits in New York, WATERS made an attempt to desert <sup>from the</sup> detachment. The officer in charge started a pursuit, accompanied by Sgt. TOWNSEND. When WATERS reached the corner of Exchange Place & Broad St., Sgt. TOWNSEND fired at him. The shot took effect at the back of the head, and he died from the effects a few minutes afterwards. The First Precinct Police arrested the pursuers and took charge of the body. They were taken to the First Precinct Station House to await the action of the Coroner.
