many other gallant officers who witnessed his conduct in the West Indies and the Frigate United States, and afterwards in the Frigate Boston, in the Mediterranean at the blockade of Tripoli. Mr. HARPER was a native of Ireland and in the Year 1798, in the abortive struggle for liberty in that ill-fated land, took an active part, was engaged in several bloody contests, in all of which he behaved bravely. At the Battle of Vinegar Hill he was wounded and at Enniscorthy,, while gallantly advancing on the enemy, who were soon afterwards routed, two of his brothers were shot down, one on each side of him; one 22 and the other 26 years of age. Mr. HARPER's conduct as clerk was characterized by invariable correctness of deportment, punctuality of attendance and a faithful discharge on all occasions of every duty assigned to him. As a man, a patriot and a Christian, Mr. HARPER did honor to the country of his birth as well as that of his adoption.
