Page 2:5 - DIED - In Cohoes on Tuesday 30th ult of pulmonary consumption, Catherine M. the wife of Giles J. SLOCUM and only surviving daughter of Judge Harvey GRANGER, of Saratoga. Her remains have been conveyed to the place of her father's sepulchre. She died in the faith of the Gospel and her memory is embalmed in the affections of all who knew her.

Page 2:5 - Gen. Gideon FOSTER, a resident of Danvers, Mass. now 95 years old is among the persons to be present at the Bunker Hill celebration. He commanded the Danvers Minutemen who fought in the Battle of Lexington and has survived all those who fought under him. He is in the enjoyment of excellent health and bids fair to live many years longer.
