Page 3:2 - DIED - In Lansingburgh on the 20th inst., in the 38th year of her age, Livonia P., wife of Rev. A.T. TWING, Rector of Trinity Church in that Village, formerly of West Troy.

Page 2:5 - MARRIED - At St. Augustine, Florida, on the 5th inst by the Rev. A. McCLURE, Capt. John SPRAGUE, A.D.C. to Miss Mary, daughter of Gen. W.J. WORTH, U.S. Army, and formerly of this Village.

DIED - In this Village on the 2d inst., Mrs. Persis RANNEY, age 73.

Page 2:4 - DEATH OF ROBERT STEWART - This gentleman to whom his brother Alexander left the whole of his immense estate and who was extremely wealthy in his own right before, died at New York on Monday in the 82d year of his age. He was Uncle to Mrs. WEBB, Mrs. STEWART &c and held previous to his death, the estate left by Alice LISPENARD, which has recently caused so much attention on account of the ejectment suits brought against it. Mr. STEWART is supposed to have received the estates of Alexander in trust covered by will for the benefit of the children of the latter. Death, the early or late visitant of all generally unfolds the closest secrets, and the mystery which attaches to several millions of dollars worth of property will now be unfolded. Mr. STEWART was married at a late period of his life but did not reside along with his wife who is still living. (from the New York Express)
