- In Albany on the 16th inst by Rev. William B. SPRAGUE, William SEARS of West Troy to Judith ADAMS of the former place.

DIED - In this Village on the 14th inst, Mr. David MOLAN, aged about 75 years - Much regretted by numerous friends.

Page 2:4 - Mr. J. BIGELOW, a young man who formerly kept a hat store in Albany and well-known as a kind, amiable, good-hearted man was murdered by the Cherokee Indians near Evansville in Arkansas on Sunday night September 7th - they murdered him for money.

Page 2:5 - MARRIED - At Troy on the 23d inst, by the Rev. L.A. SANDFORD, William MARSH to Sarah Jane PERRY, both of this town.

DIED -In this Village Thursday the 23d inst, Dr. John B. LOBDELL in the 33d year of his age. Dr. LOBDELL was a young man much respected by all who knew him and his sudden exit from this world of trouble will only admonish us that "In the midst of life we are in death"
