Page 2:2 - The dwelling of Mr. Augustus HOLDRIDGE in the Village of North Blenheim in this county was consumed by fire on Monday night and his wife and five children perished in the flames. Mr. HOLDRIDGE escaped with his youngest child, a boy of about six years of age and a daughter aged 19 saved herself though frightfully burned by leaping through a door & window (from the Schoharie Patriot - consists of a long article about the fire)

Page 2:5 - MARRIED - In Troy on the 18th inst., by the Rev. Mr. WAGONER, Mr. A.K. CARNRIKE to Miss Sarah E. HARRISON, both of this place.

Frederick - Same day in Cohoes by the Rev. Mr. FROST, Mr. LAMBY of this Village to Miss Rebecca ROBBINS, of the former place.

Page 3:1 - MARRIED - In Schoharie 24th inst. by the Rev. Hiram CHASE, John L. HACKSTAFF Esq. Editor of the Prattsville Advocate to Miss Lydia M. SMITH, daughter of Mr. Cyrus SMITH of Schoharie.

- DIED in this Village on the 25th inst., Walter Hammond, son of John M. JONES, age 1 year, 4 months & 21 days.

APRIL 7, 1847

Page 2:5 - DIED - In Shaftsbury, Vermont on the 3d of February Mrs. Deborah DENIO, aged about 83 years (long religious tract & poem)

APRIL 14, 1847

Page 2:5 - MARRIED - On Thursday last by the Rev. Mr. HOUGHTALING, Mr. Stephen CLARK of this Village to Miss Eliza Ann IVES of Troy.

APRIL 21, 1847

Page 2:5 - MARRIED - On Saturday evening 17th inst in Watervliet by Rev. Mr. GREGORY of this Village, Mr. Edmond J. LORD of Albany to Miss Hester T. THORNTON, daughter of Thomas THORNTON Esq. of Watervliet.

DIED - In this Village on Tuesday 13th inst., Mrs. Elizabeth, widow of Henry SNYDER, age 77 years.

- In Cohoes of consumption on the 17th inst Harry WINANS Esq, father of Mr. W.H.S. WINANS, Editor of the Cohoes Advertiser in the 58th year of his age.
