Page 2:1 - A WOMAN & MAN DROWNED-- This afternoon about half past 2'oclock a team attached to a barouche belonging to Mr. BEACH became unmanageable and pushed overboard from the ferryboat at the foot of Washington Street taking the carriage with five inside passengers and the drive with them. With great exertions, three passengers, one of them a lady, and the driver were rescued. The other two were drown. One of them Mrs. LYONS resided on 5th Street in this City and has a husband living but no family. The other was a Mr. Thomas REYNOLDS who it is supposed had a wife in Montreal. They were going to attend a funeral at West Troy. The horses were valuable ones and were drown. (Troy Budget of Thursday)
