Dear Sir:-I have the honor to submit herein the annual report of the Police Department of the City of Norwood for the year ending Dec.31st,1914.

As is to be expected, the demands upon this department have increased with the growth of our City, but the only addition to the department since 1908 is the Auto Patrol; and to maintain the efficiency the department must also grow.

However, I wish to say that I am more than gratified at the showing made by the department in view of the strenuous year we have just passed through, and the officers should be congratulated for the splendid manner in which they performed their duties during the past year.

The year just closed has been a very successful one from a police stand point; by this I mean a very large majority of the perpetrators of crime have been apprehended and brought to justice and the offenses committed against the citizens and City are with a few exceptions misdemeanors.

Of the property lost and stolen 86.12 % has been recovered. I sincerely hope that the incoming year will be as free from crime, and that the results will be equally as gratifying as those of the past year, which I now submit for your consideration.
