

# MT. EATON WESTLAWN CEMETERY

## Paint Township, Wayne County, Ohio

Mount Eaton West Lawn Cemetery is located in the bottom part of the southwest quarter of Section 10 and in the north part of the northwest quarter of Section 15 in Township 15 (Paint) and Range 11. It can be found on the west side of State Route 94 at the north edge of town. West Lawn Cemetery was established in 1884.

We have divided the cemetery into eight sections to help in locating burials. Our sections do not match the ones assigned by the cemetery association. On the enclosed map we have indicated where the rows start and the direction they follow. The overall layout of burials in this cemetery has been very neat and orderly which has been very easy for us to follow.

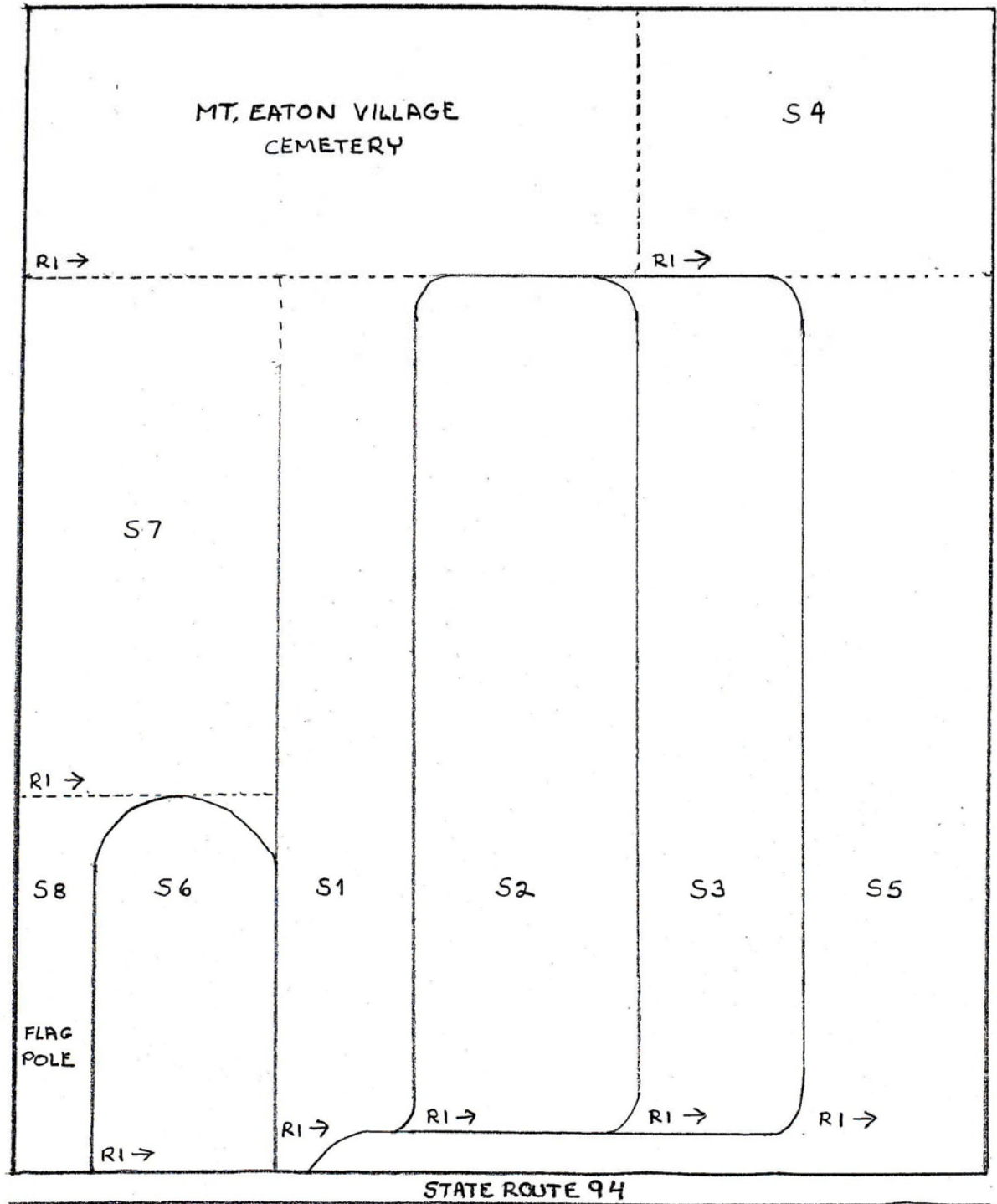
At the west end of the cemetery is a slope leading down to a line of trees. From the western most reach of the gravel driveway down to the line of trees the area is divided into two parts; one to the south and one to the north. The south half containing older burials does not belong to West Lawn Cemetery. This south section is the property of the Village of Mount Eaton and is listed separately while the north half contains newer burials that are listed as West Lawn Cemetery Section Four.

The caretaker and Sexton of West Lawn Cemetery for many years was Clayton "CJ" Hewitt who passed away on the 5<sup>th</sup> of October 2011 at the age of 81. "CJ" kept very busy with the maintenance of West Lawn despite his age, keeping a well-manicured look to the grounds. He was always present to lend a hand during our numerous visits during the summer months of 2010 and 2011 and provided us with many stories of the history of the village and the cemetery.

Although "CJ" is no longer here to maintain the cemetery, his work is being faithfully continued by his daughter, Denise Reser.
