This is a partial list of some of the major creeks, branches and streams, and all of the rivers in Greenville County, S.C. The map is made available as a genealogy reference only to help locate the general area of some creeks named in old wills, probate estates, deeds, land grants and other records.

Often creeks had various names through the generations and as one group of settlers or residents moved on and another moved in, the creeks would assume another name. Sometimes a creek would take the name of the land owner at the time and be recorded in records as such.

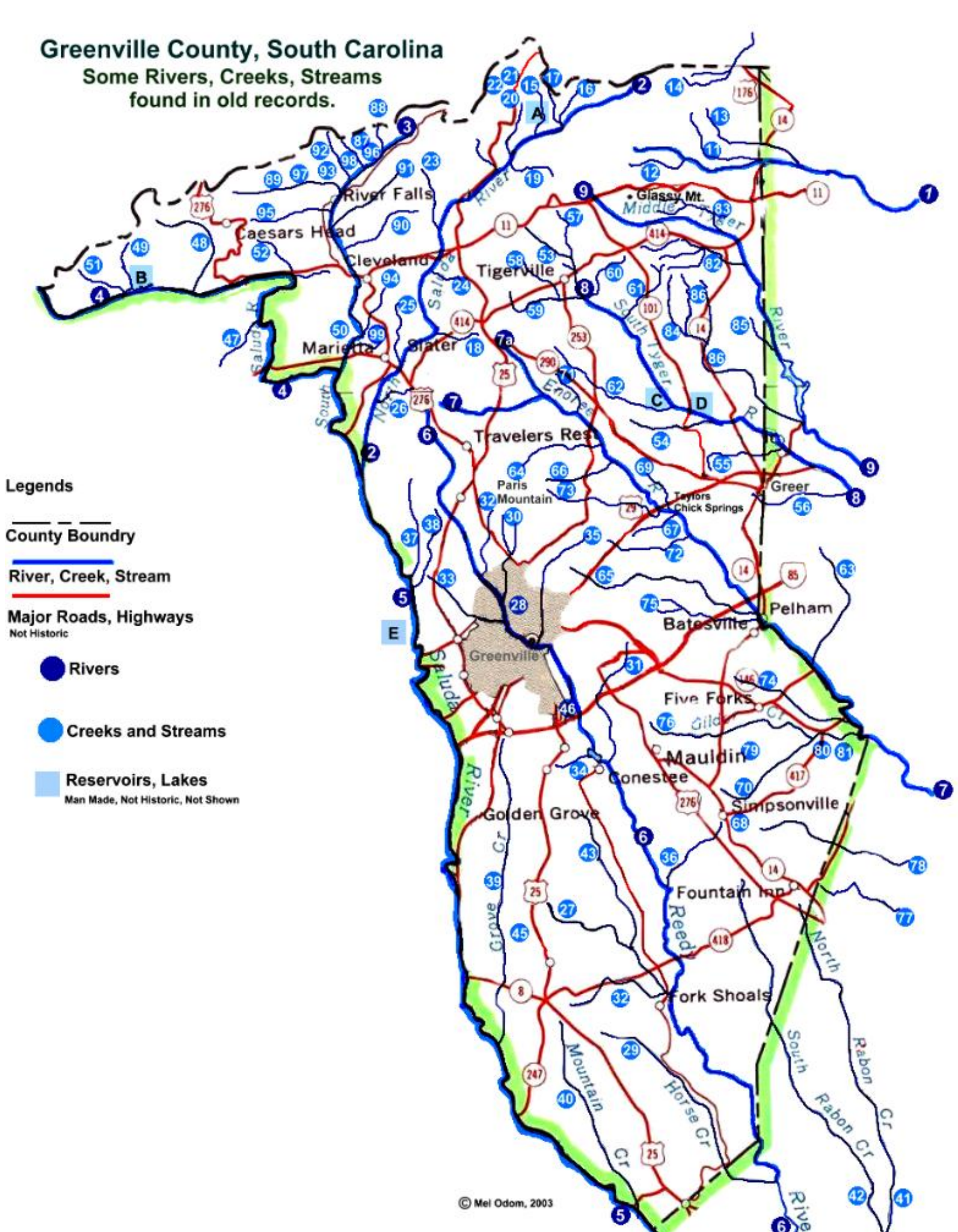
Most of the major creeks retained their original names but could have variations. Brushy Creek can be found as Brush Creek, etc. Some creeks have dried up and no longer exist, some are simply smaller branches of major creek.

It is not within the scope of this document to include all creeks and streams. For a more detailed listing of waterways you should search through maps listed on major web sites hosted by TerraServer USA, U.S. Geological Survey (USGS), Map Quest, and many others. Depending on the source, these creeks may be found having minor differences in the flow, but all will flow into the Rivers as shown here.
