D. Mitchell who being duly sworn says that  
with a regular title with Henry Jones the book  
a reservation in the Cherokee Waters ~~East~~ in an  
tract of 1817 or 1818 between the United States and  
the Indians and the heirs of the Cherokee Nation  
East ~~East~~ to contain 94 thousand and forty  
acres being more or less upon a river and said  
land was worth ten dollars per acre and that  
said man and great his lands entitled to all the  
rights of a Cherokee citizen  
sworn to and subscribed  
before me this day and  
date above written
