Maben Anderson Marlowe served as pastor to the Salem Cumberland Presbyterian Church from August 1, 1872 until October 19, 1875. (Cumberland Presbyterians united with Presbyterian Church USA, in 1906.) Something which you might find interesting is that William Jennings Bryan was a member during the time Marlowe was pastor. Bryan made a donation to the church of a pulpit which has a mother-of-pearl inlay of the burning bush -- the inscription reads: 'Nec Tamen Consumebatur' ('And yet not consumed'). This same pulpit still graces the church sancturary now. It is of great interest and beauty and we have many visitors who stop by just to see the pulpit.

I did locate the name of ARTIMISSA A MARLOWE, a member in 1873 -- this might be a relative??

Trust this will be a little something in the way of information. Sorry it can't be more.
