SMITHPORT.

- Dr. J. Milton Shields settled at Smithport in 1866, and remained there about a year. (See Covode.)
- Dr. Henry Dickison, a native of Armstrong county, studied medicine with dr. C. McEwen; located at Smithport in 1867, practiced medicine there about three years, and then moved to Missouri.
- Dr. J. W. Lydick, a native of the county, was educated at the Marion Institute; studied medicine with Dr. Pittman; attended lectures at Ann Arbor, Michigan; located in Smithport in 1871, and remained there about three years. He then located in Troutville, Clearfield county, Pa.
- Dr. E. Q. McHenry, a native of the county, was educated at Marion Institute, and studied medicine with Dr. George J. McHenry; he attended lectures at Ann Arbor, Mich., located at Smithport in 1874, and remained there about two years. He next located in Dubois, Clearfield county.
 - Dr. G. J. Reese, of Clarion county, located at Smithport in 1878, where he now resides.
