MORTALITY.

The absence of a registration law prevents us from reporting the mortality of diseases met with in the county. I am not aware that any mortuary tables have been kept by any physician in the county. But from consultation with a number of Physicians I think the following will approximate very closely to the mortality of the different diseases. In typhoid fever 1 in 15 cases; remittent fever, 1 in 40 cases; small pox, 1 in 20 cases; varialoid, none; measles, 1 in 50 cases; pneumonia, 1 in 20 cases; pleurisy, 1 in 20 cases; in different forms of nervous diseases, 1 in 50 cases; in different forms of diseases of the organs of nutrition, 1 in 15 cases.
