

CROOKED CREEK BAPTIST CHURCH.

The Crooked Creek Baptist church, with and by the advice of a large council of delegates from surrounding churches convened on the occasion, was organized December 15, 1870. Its constituent members numbered forty, all dismissed for the purpose from the Plumville Baptist church.

It is in possession of a very neat and commodious church edifice, free from debt, and bids fair to become a large and flourishing church. Thirty-eight persons have been baptized into its fellowship since its organization. Its membership at present is 73.

The following named ministers have served the church as pastors, in the order given, viz: Revs. C. H. Prescott, Aaron Neff, H. Jeffries, and the present pastor, A. B. Runyan.
