

PASTORATE OF REV. WILLIAM FULTON.

The call for Mr. Fulton was laid before the Presbytery April 12, 1864. He had preached here during the preceding winter, coming out from the seminary at Allegheny. The call was forwarded the Wheeling Presbytery, under whose care he was as a student, and accepted. In the summer of 1864 he began his labors here. His trials for ordination were heard by Presbytery at West Union, the 24th of August, 1864, and on the 25th of October following he was ordained and installed. His ministry here continued until May 3, 1870, at which time he was released and accepted a call to the Fourth U. P. Church, or Allegheny. Then his death took place, amid a sorrowing people, on the 25th of June, 1873.
