### The Family History Library has completed the digitization of the historical records of Guam

housed at the Micronesian Area Research Center (MARC) at the University of Guam. The 19th and 20th century genealogical records were digitized on 260 CD-ROMs that were deposited with MARC and at the Family History Library. University of Guam Associate professor Omaira Brunal-Perry said that the Family History Library "hoped to make the collection available via the Internet".

**Online Clipboard** - Alan Mann's always-helpful notes from his genealogy conference presentations are posted online at <http://www.alanmann.com/articles/> . There is lots of worthwhile information in his notes. In one of his classes he talked about a "shareable clipboard" -- <http://www.cl1p.net> -- where you can copy something to the online cl1pboard (Note the number 1 instead of "el" in the name and URL.) and then have it available to paste on any other computer. Great idea to use in a class so you can provide a file for everyone to download or look at. Many other uses, too.

### Questions/Answers



**QUESTION:** I've found several family references to the Boston Transcript genealogical column which the FHL has in several formats. How is the easier way to find the exact issue? I'm overwhelmed that even on microfiche there are 8 cards covering approximately a 6 month period of time.

**ANSWER:** The American Genealogical-Biographical Index (AGBI) includes the index to the two million or more personal name references that appeared in the "genealogical column" of the Boston Transcript during the forty-odd years of its publication. It is available online at [ancestry.com](http://ancestry.com).

**QUESTION:** Is there a catalog of holdings in the Logan FHC?

**ANSWER:** There is a card catalog and a computer catalog available at the Center, but there is no online catalog at this time, nor are there any current plans to create one.

**QUESTION:** Would you explain the term "Marriage Banns" and what that actually means?

**ANSWER:** Marriage banns were an announcement made in church of an intended marriage, usually for 3 weeks prior to the marriage.

**QUESTION:** Now that the FHC does not have images for the England Census, is there another website where these may be available?

**ANSWER:** FreeCen at <http://freecen.rootsweb.com/> and Census Finder at <http://www.censusfinder.com/> are 2 sites that may lead you to some free sites. They are also available at the following subscription sites that you might want to check out as well.
