NOTE: ABOUT 50 YARDS WEST OF THIS FAMILY CEMETERY IS THE GRAVE OF CAPTAIN TOM BARROW, WHO WAS KILLED 1831, BY A FOLLOWER OF NAT TURNER, DURING THE SOUTHAMPTON INSURRECTION OF THAT YEAR, CAPTAIN BARROW WAS THE FIRST TO OFFER RESISTANCE AGAINST THEM, FIGHTING UNTIL THEY KILLED HIM BY GETTING THROUGH A WINDOW AND COMING BEHIND HIM AND CUTTING HIS THROAT.

THE GRAVE OF CAPTAIN NEWETT HARRIS IS HERE, BUT NOT MARKED.

NOTE: THIS PLACE FIGURED PROMINENTLY IN THE NAT TURNER INSURRECTION OF 1831, FOR MANY YEARS THIS WAS THE HOME OF SAMUEL DREWRY FAMILY. 1974 IT BELONGS TO HINTON SMITH OF BOYKINS.

IF NOT, IT GOES "TO MY GRAND DAUGHTER," (DAUGHTER BY FIRST MARRIAGE, MARTHA BARNES, MARRIED JOHN REESE, DAUGHTER: VIRGINIA. IF VIRGINIA ELIZABETH REESE HAS NO HEIR, THE MONEY IS TO BE DIVIDED AMONG SERVANTS (AFTER PROPERTY IS SOLD).

NATHANIEL & LAVINIA FRANCIS' SON WILLIAM MARRIED BOTH GIRLS, THEN LAURA PERSON, DAUGHTER OF JOHN ANTHONY & MARY PERSON.

MASON CEMETERY

LOCATED 4 MILES NORTHWEST OF ADAMS GROVE, VA. ON ROUTE #612, FORTSVILLE ROAD; THE CEMETERY IS TWO HUNDRED YARDS DISTANT ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE HIGHWAY. COPIED BY A WORKER FOR THE WPA - 1937. COPY IN THE WALTER CECIL RAWLS LIBRARY.

THIS WAS ORIGINALLY THE BURIAL PLOT OF THE FORT FAMILY, BUT THE PROPERTY CAME INTO POSSESSION OF THE MASON FAMILY ABOUT 1828. 1937 OWNER - L.G. BAIN OF CAPRON, VA. (MARY A. MASON, D/O LEWIS AND MARY FORT - S.CO., VA. DEATH REC. BK. PAGE 83.)

THE CEMETERY IS ABOUT A HUNDRED FEET SQUARE IN SIZE, AND IS ENCLOSED BY A BRICK WALL FIVE FEET HIGH AND 1 1/2 FEET THICK. MANY MEMBERS OF THE FAMILY OF JOHN Y. MASON, NOTED STATESMAN, ARE BURIED HERE. THERE IS A MARBLE SLAB EMBEDDED IN THE WALL WITH THE FOLLOWING INSCRIPTIONS.

NOTE: THE 3RD VIRGINIA INFANTRY, CO. G, OF WHICH 5 MEMBERS ARE BURIED HERE, WAS KNOWN AS THE ROUGH & READY GUARDS AND WAS FORMED BY NATHANIEL THOMAS FRANCIS, JUNIUS RANDOLPH PERSON & JOSEPH SIMMONS GILLIAM ON THE ELEVENTH DAY OF MAY 1861, AT THE COUNTY SEAT, THEN JERUSALEM, LATER COURTLAND. THIS COMPANY WAS ORDERED TO THE MOUTH OF PAGAN CREEK, ISLE OF WIGHT COUNTY, BY THE GOVERNOR OF VIRGINIA ON MAY 26, 1861, REMAINING THERE UNTIL APRIL 1, 1862, WHEN THE COMPANY WAS MUSTERED IN THE CONFEDERATE STATES OF AMERICA. THEN ORDERED TO JOIN OTHER TROOPS AT YORKTOWN, UNDER THE IMMEDIATE COMMAND OF MAJOR GENERAL JOHN BANKHEAD MCGRUDER. AFTERWARDS ATTACHED TO THE ARMY OF NORTHERN VIRGINIA. THE ROSTER OF CO. G, LIST 137 OFFICERS AND MEN OF WHOM ONE SERGEANT AND 50 PRIVATES ARE LISTED DEAD OR KILLED BETWEEN 1861 AND 1865. JOSEPH H.M. SYKES, OF BOYKINS WAS ASST SURGEON OF 3RD VA. INF.

NOTE: PERSON'S METHODIST CHURCH, FORMERLY KNOWN AS "OLD CHURCH". THE ORIGINAL CHURCH (EPISCOPAL) WAS PROBABLY BUILT IN COLONIAL DAYS. THE BRICKS IN THE FOUNDATION HAVING BEEN BROUGHT FROM ENGLAND. ALSO THE BEAUTIFUL OLD PULPIT MADE OF MAHOGANY. THIS OLD BUILDING WAS BURNED IN THE EARLY NINETEEN HUNDREDS FROM AN OVER HEATED STOVE AS THE CONGREGATION WAS ASSEMBLING FOR SERVICES.
