



Douglas County was created in 1883 and was once part of Lincoln County. It was named after Stephen A. Douglas. Situated in the north central portion of the state, it is bounded on the east by the spectacular Grand Coulee. Groups of settlers first entered the county in 1871 and by 1883 the lure of plentiful land for cattle raising brought ranchers into the county. The late 1880s were punctuated by range wars between cattlemen and sheep raisers. The disastrous winter of 1889-90 decimated the cattle herds and brought about a shift in the economy to grain raising. Today agriculture still remains the county's main economic activity. Wheat and barley are primary crops with fruit production rapidly growing in importance.
