

Kittitas County was organized in 1883 from portions of Yakima County. Kittitas is Indian for "plenty food". The county is located east of the Cascade Mountains in the geographical center of the state. Europeans first visited the county in 1812 when members of the Pacific Fur Company passed through the region. Prior to the Civil War, Captain George

McClellan supervised military road construction through the county. In 1905 the U.S. Reclamation Service's project in the county opened up 72,000 acres for agricultural development and was of major important to the country's economic development. Today, Kittitas County is an important food processing, mixed agriculture and stock-raising center. Mining and timber also add diversity to its economy. Central Washington University at Ellensburg is the area's higher education and research center.
