



**Pierce County** Pierce County was organized in 1852 from a portion of Thurston County by the Oregon Territorial Legislature. It was named for President Franklin Pierce. It is located in the west central part of the state and stretches from Puget Sound on the west to Mount Rainier in the Cascade Mountains. The first U.S. military base established on Puget Sound was Fort Steilacoom in 1849. The county achieved prominence in the late nineteenth century when two major

transcontinental railroads made Tacoma their western terminus. Tacoma also became the headquarters for the Weyerhaeuser Company and a major Pacific shipping center. Today, Pierce County possesses a varied economy based on wood products, metal manufacturing food processing and shipping. Its county seat, Tacoma, is the state's third largest city.
