The reason UK members cannot join or renew their membership through the online sites is the fee charged by these sites for their services. UK members pay less than overseas members because the postage for the Journal is less. This benefit would disappear if UK membership was available online. The advantage for overseas members is that they do not have to pay large amounts to purchase a sterling cheque for their membership fees.
