TREASURES OF THE **NEW CHANNEL**

Tyrrell "Terry" Armstrong is our guest speaker tonight. He is a co-author of The Rainbow Chasers in the Great Florida Treasure Hunt.

Beginning in 1968 he began a career in the commercial diving industry which took him to the offshore oil fields of Texas and Louisiana. This work was followed by assignments with the great treasure salvage firms of the day along Florida's Treasure coast. He has hunted wrecks in the Caribbean as well as along Florida's east coast.

For the last six years he has worked as a sub-contractor on the Fisher salvage leases as a diver, cartographer and magnetometer operator.

Can it be said that there are parallels to be found between underwater treasure hunting and ancestor hunting?

PRE-1820 US IMMIGRATION LISTS AVAILABLE ONLINE

Originally published in the US Serial Set pertaining to the Second Session of the 16th Congress, these lists include data pertaining to 10,247 persons.

GenealogyBank.com is providing free access to these passenger lists which cover arrivals at 35 ports in 14 states and the District of Columbia between 1 October 1819 and 30 September 1820.

USING CHARACTER CODES IN GENEALOGY

Every character on a computer keyboard has a numeric code assigned to it. Characters that aren't on the keyboard have numeric codes, too.

For example, the capital letter X is assigned a code of ALT + 088. The code for the capital letter Y is ALT + 089. Note: ALT + indicates that you need to hold the ALT key down while you press the assigned numbers on the numeric keypad.

If the numeric code begins with a 0 (zero) you must enter it. Do not use the letter O. Do NOT use the number keys at the top of the keyboard as these numbers have different codes assigned to them.

Any symbol not in the 26 letter English alphabet can be printed by using the numeric code assigned to it. This becomes very important when doing foreign research.

Rootsweb provides an excellent chart so you will not have to remember the codes. It is called the Character Codes of Umlauted Vowels and Symbols. To view the chart:

Or save page three of this newsletter for future reference.

Surnames entered using these numeric codes can be entered in the Rootsweb's WorldConnect Project, Surname List (RSL), Surname Helper and message boards.

One word of caution: Since some researchers will not use character codes when doing searches, you may want to list your surnames with and without using the codes so your entries are not missed.

These numberic codes will also work with most commonly used genealogy and word processing programs.
