FORWARD

Therefore, even if your ancestors were not Presbyterian, or in Madonna or Bel Air, you may still find a nugget of gold here.

INTRODUCTION by Henry C. Peden, Jr.

Rev. Thomas Stuart Crowe Smith was born in Nova Scotia in 1817 and came to Harford County, Maryland in 1857. He served as pastor of Bethel Presbyterian Church and Bel Air Presbyterian Church from 1857 until his death in 1869. During his time of service, Rev. Smith kept three diaries and the originals are in the church office of Bethel Presbyterian Church, 4136 Norrisville Road White Hall, MD 21161, in northwestern Harford County. With permission of the church, photocopies of the diaries were made by Henry C. Peden, Jr. and Mrs. Mary B. White and deposited in the Archives Department of the Historical Society of Harford County, 143 N. Main Street, Bel Air, MD 21014. For genealogical purposes, vital information such as births, baptisms, marriages, deaths and burials were gleaned from the diaries and annotated with additional information shown in brackets as [*Ed. Note*]. Names have been arranged alphabetically and cross-referenced within the text, using the standard designation *q.v.* (meaning *quod vide* or "which see"). These abstracts are very important to researchers due to the lack of State or County vital records that were not created by law until 1898 in the counties of Maryland.
