Sixteen miles north of Augusta, and seventy-five miles from Portland, on Maine Central and terminus of the Somerset Railway. Set off from Waterville and incorporated as West Waterville Feb. 26, 1873. Name changed to Oakland March 10, 1883. Population 1910, 2,257. Population 1920, 2,473. Polls, 761. Estates, \$1,496,799.

The post-office address is given only when the same does not correspond with the name of the town above, and appears immediately after the name and occupation.
