

Copy of original Will of William Vance, Sr. Will executed 9 June 1854

In the Name of God Amen

I William Vance <sup>of</sup> of the Township of Reedsville  
in the County of Highland and State of Ohio, consider  
the uncertainty of life and the certainty of Death and being

of sound and perfect mind and memory blessed be Alonity

God for the same I do make and publish this my last

will and Testame <sup>n</sup> in manner and form following that is to  
say give and devise <sup>this four hundred dollar is given unto my wife</sup> to my son Isaac Vance four hundred

Dollars, I give and Devise <sup>to my</sup> Daughter Rebecca Halford four.

One hundred Dollars I give and devise to my son Thomas Vance

six hundred Dollars, I give and Devise to my Daughter

Ann Griffith three hundred Dollars to be her share in  
full, I give and devise to my son Jacob Vance five

hundred Dollars, I give and devise to my son William  
Vance ten hundred Dollars, I give and devise to my  
Daughter Mary Wealeen four hundred Dollars

I give and devise to my son Minton Vance fifteen

hundred Dollars, I give and devise to my son Brownlee  
Vance the farm he now lives on clear of all incumbe-

racy, I give and devise to my son Davis Vance seven  
hundred Dollars, I give and devise to my son Lemuel

Vance eight hundred Dollars, I give and devise

to my Daughter Margaret Vance six hundred

Dollars, I give and Devise to my Daughter Ruth

Mcconnahay four hundred Dollars, I give and

devise to my granddaughter Ann Conn one hundred

Dollars I give and devise to my granddaughter Mahetahle

Conn one hundred Dollars, I give and Devise to my

granddaughter Lucy Vance one hundred Dollars

I give and Devise to my Grandson John P. Smith

75 Dollars I give and devise to my grandson  
James Barnett 75 Dollars the money I have  
left to my gran Children is to be paid to them  
when Married or come of age; By my Executors  
I give and devise to Rachel Vance my wife two beads  
and bedding one Table and Island eleven Chairs two  
bead Maes one Cow one horse if she want one —  
Mother must have twenty <sup>five</sup> Dollars at my Death, my  
Executors shall be bound to pay there Mother  
Every three Monthes as much as she thinks she  
stands in need of she may judge for herself  
All the accounts Book and notes is to be stellled out  
out of the sume I have left to each one of my  
Children and gran Children  
There by direct my Executors and impower them to sell  
all my lands and make Deeds for the same collect all  
Money and pay all I have willed to if there is anuff  
Devoid my movables welke next making a cail you  
must <sup>but</sup> money Anuff to pay on interest to supply  
Mother as long as she lives then devoid the balance in  
the same proportion as I have willed William Vance  
And lastly I do hereby Constituite and Apoint my Sons  
Jacob Vance, William <sup>th</sup> Vance Mirtur Vance  
Broconfield Vance, Executors in equal power to do  
business of this my last will and Testament in  
Witness whereof I have here unto set my hand  
and affixed <sup>my</sup> Seal this nineteenth day of June in the  
year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and  
fifty four signed sealed and published and declar'd

by the aforesaid William Vance to be his last will and  
Testament in the presence of us who have hereunto  
subscribed our names as Witnesses in the presence  
of the testator. ~~Wm~~ Jacob Socay Jr. and ~~John~~ D. Spring  
Devoid my movables wch<sup>t</sup> out making acait you  
myt<sup>t</sup> <sup>but</sup> money Anuff to pay on interest to supply  
Mother as long as she lives Then devoid the balance in  
the same proportion as I have willed William Vance  
And lastly I do hereby Constitute and Apoint my Sons  
Jacob Vance, William<sup>t</sup> Vance Minton Vance  
Broonfeld Vance, Executors in Equal power to do  
business of this my last will and Testament in  
Witness whereof I have here wro<sup>t</sup> Set my hand  
and Affixed <sup>my</sup> Seal the ninth day of June in the  
year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and  
fifty four Signed sealed and published and declar'd  
by the aforesaid William Vance to be his last will and  
Testament in the presence of us who have hereunto  
subscribed our names as Witnesses in the presence
