Amboy twp was settled nearly as early as any of the other twp's of Fulton county. The first settler of Amboy being Jared Hoadly who entered in July of 1833. Also in 1833, there came to

Amboy Twp. Alvah Steadman, Aaron Steadman, and their father, David Steadman. Alvah Steadman is credited with being the 2nd settler in Amboy Twp. In 1834 came David Duncan from Onondaga Co. NY, also John Blain & Jerry Duncan, from the same place. Lorenzo Abbott and Seneca Corbin from NY, Park WHITE and his son David WHITE, Jonathan & Clark Gilson, James Hallett, John LaBounty, Samuel Purdy, Nathaniel and Harry Welch.

David was an early settler of Fulton Co. settling here in 1834. David is also buried in Jordan Cemetery in the next row and died Jan 22 1898 and stone has a GAR marker. His wife's stone has the name "Tryphena" (Maggie must have been nickname) and she died Feb 4 1864 at age 40y. David was constable of Amboy Township for several years. In 1870 David is listed in Branch County, MI Census with wife Celicia L. In 1880 census he is back in Amboy Township,

Fulton County, Ohio and his wife is listed as "Maggie" age 55 which I believe is still Louisa, both the 1870 and 1880 census have her born in NY.

The plat map for Amboy Twp in 1875 has D. White in section 7 and across the road to south it has M. White in section 18. In 1858 plat D. White is also in the same parcel of section 7 but the parcel in section 18 south has P. White.

Then the 1888 plat map shows the parcel of section 7 is now owned by C. C. White and the parcel of section 18 has Mary E. White. Then in the 1903 plat section the parcel in section 7 is no longer owned by White, it is owned by a Jonathon L. Bilhor, but the parcel in section 18 still has name Mary White.

David, the son of Park White became a noted hunter in the wilds of this country, but since the advancement of civilization and the woodman's axe, game in later years has become so scarce to yield no profit. He sought the wilderness of Northern Michigan, and makes hunting profitable.

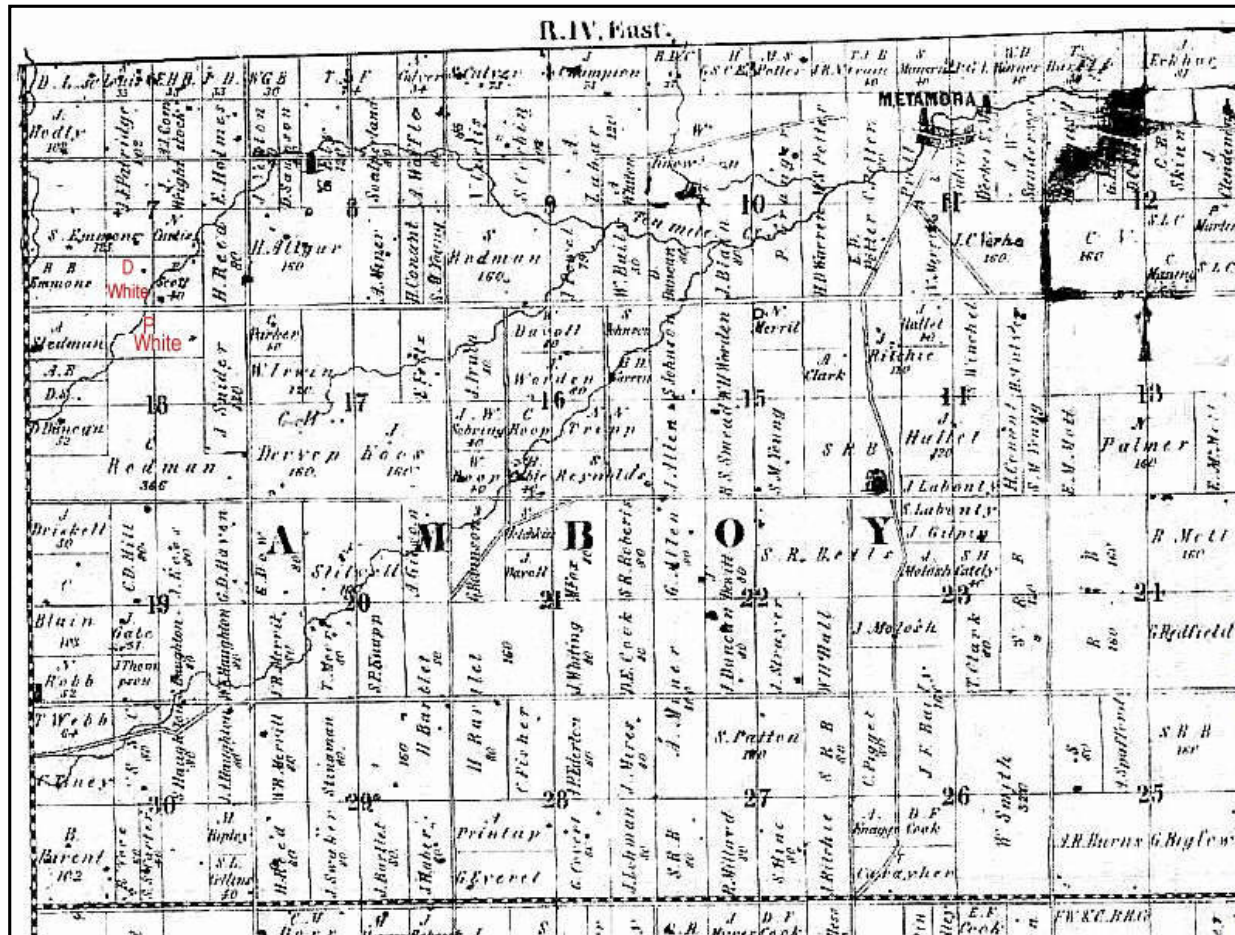

Park White's Claim

War of 1812



State of Ohio.

Fulton County

On this 15th day of July AD 1858 personally appeared before me, a justice of the peace within and for the state and county aforesaid, Park White, aged sixty two years, a resident of Amboy Township, state and county aforesaid, who being duly sworn according to law, declared that he is the identical Park White who was a private in the Platsburg Regiment. The first service affiant rendered was to the best of affiant's knowledge and belief, in the month of June AD 1813 and consisted to best of his knowledge of ten days, it was during the time known as the "Alarm". The exact day of entering when said service or of leaving it during this campaign the affiant cannot specify. During this term of services the name of the captain under whom affiant served was Nathaniel Cochrane; the Major was Turner, first name not known, Colonel was John Roberts, the whole commanded by General Moore. The second term affiant served was during, as affiant verily believes, the month of September AD 1814; the time served to best of affiant's knowledge and belief was fourteen days in Platsburg Regiment in a

volunteer company of Light Horse under Captain Sperry (affiant believes John Sperry) the other officers affiant believes to have been as above mentioned ____ ____ General Moore, Colonel Roberts, Major Turner which service was performed in the war with Great Britain declared by the United States on the 18th of day of June AD 1812. The first service was performed as a private in the militia, the latter as a light horseman as above stated. During the last term of services affiant was engaged in a skirmish on Sunday (affiant believes on Sept. 11th 1814) on the Plattsburg Plains. During last term of service affiant received at the termination thereof for his service affiant believes nine dollars, affiant states that he was in receipt of ____ regular rations during last term and that affiant to the best of his knowledge paid out for his own fare and for horse feed and care, nine dollars

At the time of and after the performance of the services above mentioned affiant states that he was a resident of the Town of Peru, Clinton County, State of New York. Affiant states further that he applied for a land warrant under the law of the United States passed A.D. 1850 and that he has received said Warrant. It was issued Jan 6th 1857. It's number is 52,400. The affiant makes this affidavit for the purpose of obtaining what may be found his due under the law ____ by the New York Legislature April 15 AD 1857 for the adjustment of the New York Militia Claims of 1812.
