ELIGIBILITY

Membership in the Auxiliary to the Sons of Union Veterans of the Civil War can be obtained through eligibility in several classes:

FIRST: Female descendants who are a daughter, granddaughter, great-granddaughter, great-great-granddaughter, great-great-great-granddaughter, legally adopted daughter, niece, great-niece, etc. (who is not less than twelve (12) years of age) of the soldiers, sailors, marines, or Revenue Cutter Service, regularly mustered and honorably discharged from the Army, Navy, Marine Corps, or Revenue Cutter Service, of the United States of America during the War of the Rebellion, 1861-1865.

SECOND: Wives, mothers, widows, or legally adopted daughters of a Son of a Union Veteran of the Civil War with lineage who is a member in good standing.

ASSOCIATE

Women who do not have the ancestry to qualify for hereditary membership but who demonstrate a genuine interest in the Civil War and who can subscribe to the purpose and objects of the Auxiliary.

JUNIOR

Young ladies who have attained eight (8) years of age.
