Lana Davis, president of the John McKnitt Chapter from Cookeville, Tennessee, recently participated in the reenactment of the siege of Fort Watauga in Elizabethton, Tennessee, which occurred on July 21, 1776, when about three hundred Cherokee warriors attacked the fort. Under the command of Captain James Robertson and Lieutenant John Sevier, the fort was successfully defended with minimal casualties among the settlers. President Davis played the role of assisting Ann Robertson extinguishing the fire set to the fort walls by the Cherokee. Over 200 reenactors participated in the two day event. President Lana Davis is the only member of Colonial Dames XVII Century in Tennessee who has 50 supplemental, for which she recently received her pin. She also has 25 Coat of Arms.
