

The CCGS Continues Project

The Conway County (Arkansas) Genealogical Society is continuing its group project to construct a county-wide genealogy database of Conway County families. Anyone who has their Conway County family lines in a computerized database is asked to create a GEDCOM file of their database and submit it to the CCGS. We would prefer that the file be privatized before being submitted. (Most commercial genealogy programs, such as Family Tree Maker, Personal Ancestral File, Master Genealogist, and many others can remove sensitive information on living relatives before creating and exporting a GEDCOM file). If you should have problems removing dates and personal information, we can try to do it for you. Just let us know that the data needs to be privatized before it is placed on our public computer system. If we cannot remove it we will notify you. You may submit your file on 3.5 inch floppy disks or on CDs.

County Wide Family File is accessible on the computers in the Research Room located in the Morrilton Depot Museum. We hope that this database will grow continuously and will be a valuable asset to anyone doing research in the county. You can help insure success by submitting your family data. You don't have to be a member of the CCGS to participate (although we would love to have you join our Society).
