Would you please post a query about the following family in Conway County? Before 1830, a man named Frederick FLETCHER moved his family to Point Remove, Conway County. He had previously served (1827) as a magistrate for Crawford and Hope Counties in Arkansas and was a captain of the Crawford County Cavalry. Frederick FLETCHER received bounty land in Arkansas for his service as a sergeant in Rothrock's company of the 38th Infantry. He built a toll bridge across Point Remove Creek and advertised its opening in the Arkansas Gazette. He was the census enumerator for Conway County in 1830 and 1840 and wrote with a fine hand. His wife's name was Mary and they had seven known children: Nancy who married Pleasant LEMLEY, Sarah A. who married William H. MURPHY, Clark who married Tabitha S. CHILDERS, Susan or Lavinia, Margaret, Martin, and Elizabeth who married Thomas Henry MINYARD.
