Hello, I was hoping you could help me. My gg-grandfather was David Rochell b. 1840

Tennessee/Alabama. His family moved to Mississippi from Alabama. Then after serving in the Civil War along with 2 of his brothers he moved to Arkansas. He married Jane Unknown b. 1846 Arkansas. I find them first in the 1870 US Federal Census in Sebastian Cty with their son (my g-grandfather) Thomas and later the same year I find just Jane & Thomas in Conway county living alone. Their name is spelled Rochel both times. By 1880 Thomas is living with someone named L. F. Burns and a Sarah J. Straughn, and he is listed as 'something other than a direct relative'. My question is if you could find a record of Jane Rochell's death or burial, or maybe a probate record or adoption record for Thomas Rochell? I believe David was one of the first Rochell's to move to Arkansas as I do not find any others until the 1880's. Any help would be appreciated. TYLER and SELF families. Henry TYLER and his wife Amanda SELF are my great grandparents. I would like to make contact with others who have information on these families or may know something about them. This is what I have: Henry Tom TYLER was b 10 Oct 1858 in Many, LA (Sabine Parish) and d 19 Nov 1946 in Mart, TX. He married Amanda Georgia SELF 21 Oct 1875 in Darnell, LA (Sabine Parish). Amanda was b 14 Feb 1860 in Darnell, LA, and was the daughter of James SELF and Matilda LARGENT. Amanda d 19 Oct 1938 in Mart, TX. Henry and Amanda are buried in Bell Springs Cemetery in Hill County, TX. Henry and Amanda lived in AR in the 1880's where three of their children were born. I do not know where they lived in AR. We believe Henry's father was John TYLER and his mother was Rosie FRANKS. The family stories are the Tyler family lived in TX in the early 1800's and later lived in AR and LA. The SELF family traveled with them several times and there were several marriages between the two families. Contact James H.
