He pitched for the Memphis Chicks all or part of 10 seasons and was a consistent 20-game winner. He was noted for his iron man ?oles, pitching Sunday doubleheaders on home appearances mainly. He also pitched for New Orleans, Birmingham and Atlanta. His record in the league was 173 victories and 15 defeats. During his baseball career, Kelley had parts of six seasons in the majors, his best years being with the Philadelphia Athletics where he had records of 15-12 and 13-21, and 9-8 and 4-3 records with the Washington Senators. Kelley came by the name of "Parkin Kid" legitimately having been signed to play pro ball when only 16 years of age. The name stuck with him until his retirement. Funeral services were held at 3:30 Tuesday afternoon at the First United Methodist Church in Parkin with the Rev. Charles Lewis officiating. Burial was in Cogbill Cem. near Wynne with Citizens Funeral Home of West Memphis in charge. He leaves his wife; two sons, Bryan Kelley of Earle, and Harry Kelley Jr. of Gulfport, Miss.; his mother, Mrs. Bertha Kelley of Parkin; a brother, Alfred Kelley of Parkin, and a sister, Mrs. A. L. Stephens of Parkin. Note: Harry Kelley's birthdate was February 13, 1906. He passed away in his home in Parkin with his family present. Harry Kelley started playing baseball in 1922 when he was sixteen. Kelley broke into the bigs on April 16, 1925 with the Washington Senators. He graduated Wynne High School, Vanderbilt University in Nashville, Tennessee, the University of Arkansas and University of Arkansas Law School. He entered the Army in July 1943 and received his basic training at the Armored Training Center, Fort Knox, Kentucky. In February 1944, he was sent to England as a member of an armored replacement pool; moved to the European Theater in August 1944 and joined the Second Armored Division in Holland in early September 1944. There he became a crew member of a Sherman Tank; initial military actions were near Aachen, Germany; other actions were in the Ruhr River Area near Aachen and the Rhine River. These engagements lasted until after Thanksgiving 1944. The German offensive, later known in history as "The Battle of the Bulge" began December 1944. The Second Armored was ordered back to Belgium to help stop the German Spearhead. The Division's efforts were successful, and the last element of the German Army retreated from Belgium in the latter part of January 1945. After other military engagements west of the Rhine river, the Division made a successful crossing of the River in March of 1945. The Division continued to advance into the heartland of Germany until it reached the Elbe River near the city of Magdeburg. While at Magdeburg, President Truman ordered that no more advance toward Berlin would be made and that the Russians would be permitted to capture the city. The gladly accepted the order. It was later learned that the Russians had over 100,000 casualties in taking Berlin. After World War II ended in May 1945 a decision was made whereby the city would be occupied by troops from Britian, Russia, France and the United States. The Second Armored was chosen to represent the United States, and it moved into Berlin July 1945. The heads of state of the allied countries held a conference (known as the Potsdam Conference) during July. The division passed in review before Churchill, Truman, (Stalin was absent) Generals Eisenhower, DeGaulle, Marshall, Arnold, Montgomery, Pat ton, Temoshenko and Bradley. In August 1945, the division was transferred to a former German Army post near Frankfurt for occupation duty. Killough returned home on an emergency furlough in October 1945 and was discharged in November 1945. He had earned the European Theater of Operations Ribbon with Stars for battle engagements and as a member of Second Armored Division - the Division received a Presidential Citation and Fourage're from the Belgium government for it accomplishments in helping to stop the German offensive during the Ardennes Forest Following his discharge in November 1945, John and Esther Williams were Campaign. married and they have three sons: Oliver Neil Killough, II, Stephen Malone and Walter Kyle. John returned to school and completed pre-law and his law degree. He started his law practice 1 July 1950 and retired 1 July 2000. John's hobbies are tennis, golf and walking.
