of Franklin of the same Part and George Turnbull of the State of Virginia  
and County of Franklin of the other Part Witnesses that the said Wm. Ray  
for and in Consideration of the full and just sum of two hundred  
Pounds to him in hand Paid & with granted Bargained Sold & Del-  
ivered to the said George Turnbull one certain Tract or Parcel of Land  
containing three hundred Acres lying being in Franklin County on both  
sides of a long gully Creek it being a certain Tract or Parcel of Land  
Conveyed from Joseph Ray Sheriff of the State of Virginia by Will to  
Andrew Ray & John Ray Heir of said Joseph Ray dec'd & Remained  
in followers Viz. Beginning at a white oak on the said Creek  
thence of N. 40. E. 66. poles to a red oak N. 12. W. 168. Poles to a white  
Oak N. 67. W. 280. Poles to a red oak S. 5. W. 14. Poles to a Cypress
