## Researching Canadian Military Records Using Online & Traditional Resources An Introduction for Family Historians

An impressive quantity of primary Canadian military records have recently been digitized and made available for research on the internet. Notable exceptions include military personnel records for the period after 1918. Those records must still be applied for in writing. The restrictions regarding which personnel records are available are described on the web link listed under the heading *How to Access Military Personnel Files after 1918*, as is the address to send your application to.

Many family historians are delighted to discover that there is a rapidly growing archive of reliable background information and Canadian military history online.

Inexperienced family historians often rely exclusively on web-based records. It is important to remember that online information represents a fraction of that what is available. This writer strongly supports using available online resources, however it is critically important for researchers to seek out published accounts of events and individuals that are of interest to you. Books from serious authors usually contain far more detail and include extensive source citation and notes, whereas online information is often lacking in those areas. Useful online tools to help you identify those published works include web-based bibliographies.
