tolm Ligurds on has become a British subject and is within Canada entitled to all political and other rights and privileges and is subject to all obligations to which a natural born British'subject is entitled or subject, within Canada, with this qualification, that he shall not within the limits of the Foreign State of which he was a subject previous to the date hereof be deemed to be a British subject, unless he has ceased to be a subject of that State, in pursuance of the laws thereof, or in pursuance of a Treaty or Convention to that effect.
