**Marriage (18 Jan 1858):** Kozee says 10 Feb 1858, "That she was married under the name of Lavina Chandler to said Charles Pack on the 10 day of February 1858 by E. Green at Henry Chandlers' and records from Johnson co. Ky say the 18th. Vital Statistics say, 18 Jan 1858. Charles age 25, and Lavisa age 17.

**Census (fam) (11 Jul 1860):** He is listed as age 27.

On August 26, when Sherman's grand-wheel movement was underway, Gallup noted, "General Sherman and his train is now passing where we are constructing our new line of works".

After the end of the Atlanta Campaign the XXIII Army Corps camped at Decatur and then participated in the pursuit of Hood. In November 1864, the 14th KY, was ordered to Johnsonville, Tennessee, where it almost encountered Shermans nemesis "that devil Forrest", missing him only by one day, after his attack on the gunboats and federal depots at Johnsonville.

Only days before the Battle of Franklin, the 14th KY was recalled by the governor of Kentucky. It arrived at Louisa ca. November 21, where it was mustered out on January 31, 1865. The recruits and veterans of the 14th KY were organized as the 14th KY Battalion which was mustered out on September 15, 1865 at Louisville.

There is no doubt the the men were proud of their Uncle Billy. The Atlanta Campaign and their commander made an impact on their lives - it was something they never forgot and also told their children and grandchildren about, some of whom bore **Sherman's** name.

**Will (20 Jun 1900):** I, Charles Pack of Sip Johnson county, Kentucky, do this make my last will and testament.

I give and bequeath to my beloved daughters Perlina & Lareugh Pack one organ the east of which is &75 Seventy Five Dollars the same to come out of the one hundred Dollars the same to come out of the one hundred Dollars due each all of the older heirs has been given one hundred Dollars each except Elizabeth Wheeler heirs the other one Hundred & twenty five Dollars due said Perlina & lareugh Pack to out of my real estate to wit, a tract of land and bounded as follows tawit. Beginning ona while oak standing on the right side of the left hand ford of the meadow branch a tributary of the rock house fork of Hood a corner of Garfield Pack near a cool bank thence westward down the branch with same to the forks of the road that leads up the right hand fork of the meadow branch thence S.E. up the point to Isaac Chandler Sr. line, thence with said Chandler and Packs line to Garfield Packs line, thence with said Gas Pack line to the beginning continuing about 35 acres.

The said Perlina & Lareugh Pack to sell or keep enough of the said land at five dollars per acre to satisfy the one hundred & twenty five dollars due them, said Perlina & Lareugh Pack shall have out of personal property one cane each, one feather bed and beading each.

I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Lavina Pack out of my real estate one tract of land the old homestead situated in Johnson County and state of Ky. and bounded as follows to wit. being on the rock house ford of hood, beginning on a rock a corner made by Charles Pack and Sherman Pack on the left hand fork of the meadow branch, thence north with the said S. Pack's line to the top of the ridge between the

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meadow branch and the James Chandler branch, thence west with the top of the ridge to where the two fences connects at the westend of the ridge on the top of the knob, thence a straight line west to the head of a little draw, then with the draw to the creek said line from the top of said knob to the creek was made by Henry Chandler, Charles Pack, John Chandler, M. T. Nickel thence up the creek to a sycamore a corner made by Henry Chandler, & Allen Pack, thence up the branch west to the mouth of the first left hand draw thence up the draw to the top of the point, thence with the ridge to George Chandler's line, thence said line to a conditional line made by Henry Chandler & Isaac Chandler Sr. thence with said con. line eastward to a white oak at the branch, thence same cause cross the branch with the same line to the top of the ridge to a small chestnut, thence south with the ridge to Isaac Chandler, jr. line, thence with said line down the hill to road that leads to said Chandler, thence with said road to where its connects the Co. road, thence with the branch to the beginning.

To have and to hold with all the appertenance there to during her life the said Lavina Pack my beloved wife to have and controll all of my personal property during her life.

To my beloved son Roscoe Pack I give and bequeath all of said real estate bounded to my beloved wife Lavina Pack at her death under conditions herein after stated. My son, Roscoe Pack shall pay to Henry Wheeler's two heirs Ethel and Herbut grandchildren by my daughter Elizabeth see One Hundred Dollars out of said real estate, the said Rosco Pack my son shall stay and work and take good care of his mother as long as she liveth and see that she is provided and cared for and if he does not comply with the conditions above stated he is to only share with the other heirs if these conditions is complied with the real estate laid out for him shall be his dowery of all my real estate and personal property /////. the house furniture he shall have the same the the other heirs got such as bed & bedding, the said real estate described belongs to Sherman Pack my son also the land that it sits on and swin feet on the length of the building belongs to same and shall not be rickend as part or parcel of the real estate described.

The remainder of my real estate shall be equally divided between my eleven heirs or heirs heirs if there should be \_\_\_\_\_. this testament at the death of Lavina Pack shall also be equally divided between my eleven heirs or their heirs.

I also request that James Chandler adm'r of Henry Chandler dec'd that he and John J. Brown together to divide the land equally between my self or my heirs and the heirs of Henry Chandler Dec'd, lying in the right hand fork of the Meadow branch. Given under my hand this 20th day of June 1900.
