Magbee Drive is a one block long street running from McCauley Street to South Cobb Drive in the neighborhood of the City of Smyrna's King Spring Park. Frame houses constructed by the Bennett family in the early 1950's line the street. The length of the street, however, does not reflect the impact the Magbee family had on the area in the mid and late 1800's and up into the 1900's. An estate file on record in the Georgia Department of Archives and History on Laban Magbee is a valuable historical document of the War Between the States era showing the values of slaves and goods at the height of the war but just a few months prior to the actual fighting in Cobb County. It also shows the names of many residents of the area who participated in the estate sale. You will also note the inflated food prices and the difference in the value of the appraisal which occured in June, 1863, and the values at the sale in October, 1863.
