

Nellie H. Durden

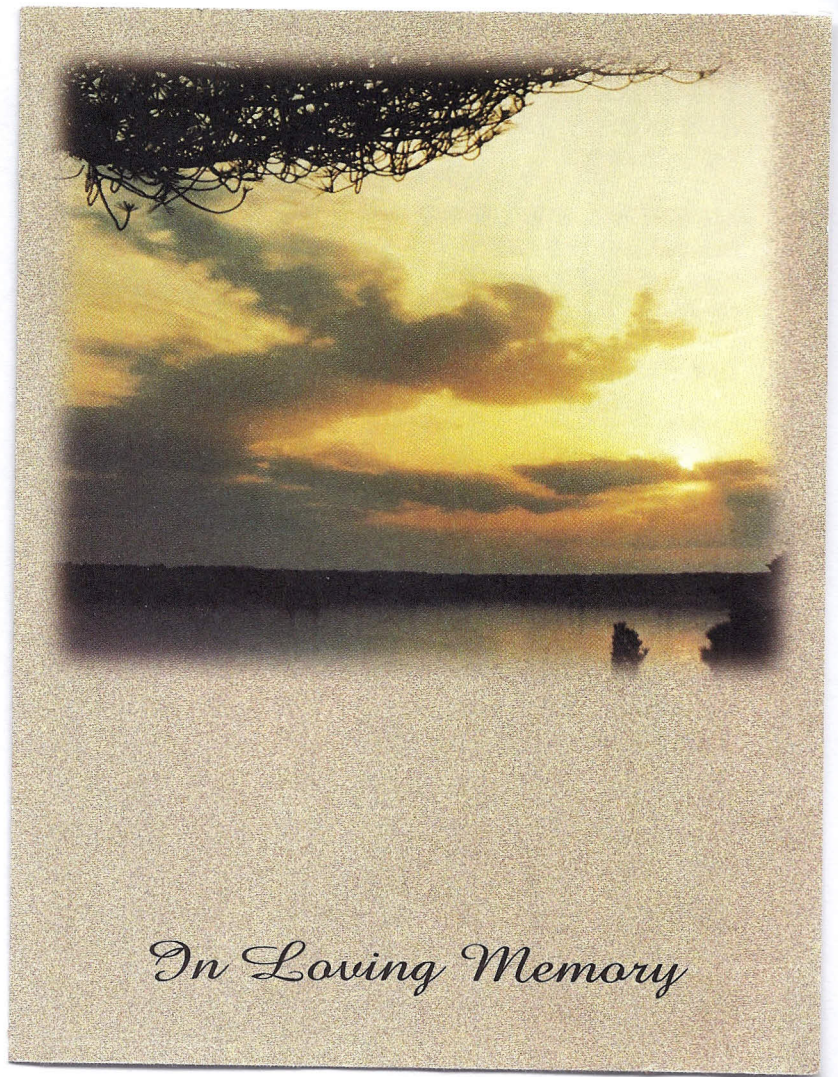
Nellie H. Durden, 69, of Loganville died March 6, 2003.
