

Campbell, James Bevan (Bev) (mainly based on the book by Roger Underwood (2006) "The Old Growth Foresters")

Born 1928 Mukinbudin. Good at sport, including golf, tennis, football, rugby. Graduated from Australian Forestry School in 1949. Started with Forests Department in 1954-55, at same time as Barney White, Phil Shedley and Don Stanley. Appointed as an overseer at Pemberton, then transferred to Dwellingup. Then joined the Commonwealth Forestry Bureau in Melbourne, monitoring timber movements. In 1970s, returned to Forests Department as District Forests Officer in Harvey. In Harvey for 15 years, then Superintendent of Northern Forests, in Perth, in early 1970s. Became Chief of Division, after Don Stewart retired. Responsible for log supply, assisted by John Sclater and Alan Hill. Shortly after CALM created in 1985, moved to the Timber Bureau. After a few weeks, resigned, to work as a consultant.
