Australian Forestry School final year 1945.

Born at Adelaide. His science degree at the University of Adelaide was completed part-time over eight years, and it was not until 1944 that he began the course at the Australian Forestry School, Canberra. On his return to South Australia, Mr Lewis joined the Woods and Forests Department. He began work under Bob Stolz at Mount Gambier Forest and then became part of the Working Plans Field Section investigating and assessing the South East forests. By the time of his retirement in 1981, Mr Lewis had reached the rank of Assistant Director, Forest Operations Division, in head office, Adelaide. Mr Lewis was awarded the Russell Grimwade Scholarship in 1957, and the N W Jolly medal for outstanding service to forestry.
