Associate Professor of physics Clark University 1965-67, concurrently visiting professor University of Washington 1965. Did Bachelor of Arts 1956 University of Chicago, Masters 1958, PhD political science University of Chicago. Associate Professor of political science Eastern Kentucky Uni 1972+. Spent time in physics faculty Freiburg 1974-75 and visiting professor Munchen Technical University 1967-68. Lived in Kiel 1931-38, Baton Rouge 1938, Chicago 1956-58, Kentucky 1972-96. In 1996 retired in Louisville KY. In 1998, Associate Professor Emeriti, Physics Dept at University of New York in Buffalo. Also worked as lecturer at Syracuse Uni and Oklahoma State University and Lafayette College (Easton PA). Researched hydrogen atom, spectroscopy, molecular structure, super conducting magnets and electro dynamics. He was a law student at Uni of Louisville c1996-98.
