

This artifact is a reunion photo album of Company E, 85th Regiment of Indiana Infantry of the Grand Army of the Republic (i.e., surviving veterans of the Union Army of the Civil War). The album is on display in the museum of the Crawford County Illinois Historical Society, 408 S. Cross St., Robinson, IL. The album is undated. It was scanned for internet use in May, 2016 by the Historical Society.

As can be seen in the scans, a few of the portraits have been labeled, over the years, with these names and annotations:
