HABEGGER TOT DIES TUESDAY

Flossie Jean Habegger Is Victim of Pneumonia

Funeral Today

Flossie Jean Habegger, 3 months old daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Enoch P. Habegger living three and one half miles north of town, along highway 27, died Tuesday evening at the Fort Wayne Lutheran hospital. The tot suffered from double pneumonia and was under the care of a special child specialist for several days, but medical attention proved futile. She ailed several weeks.

The child was born on January 3, the daughter of Enoch and Emma Mazelin Habegger. She was the first child born in the south half of the county in 1934 and received many prizes.

Surviving are the parents and a small sister, Helen Louise. One brother preceded.

The funeral was held at the home this afternoon.
