Martin D. Habegger, 92, of Berne, a Monroe Township dairy and grain farmer, died Thursday, Feb. 7, 2002, at Adams County Memorial Hospital.

The Adams County native had also worked for Central Sugar Co. in Decatur and Pioneer Hybrid International Seed as a salesman. He recently served on the advisory board of the Adams County Farm Bureau Credit Union. He was a member of Zion Lutheran Church in Decatur, a former member of the Holstein Association and Lions Club, and was a World War II Army veteran.
