EZRA BRANDYBERRY DIES LAST EVENING

Ezra O. Brandyberry, 63, veteran employe of the Decatur General Electric Co. plant until his retirement, died suddenly at 6 o'clock Tuesday evening at his home, 607 Marshall Street.

He was born at Monroe Aug. 2, 1899, a son of Dennis and Ella Wisler-Brandyberry, and was married to Lena Pearson October 19, 1920.

Mr. Brandyberry was employed as an inspector at the G. E. plant for 33 years until his retirement in November of 1961 because of ill health.

Surviving in addition to his wife, are one daughter, Mrs. Robert A. (Anna) Miller and two grandsons, Stephen and Timothy. The son-in-law is a missionary in Europe, but the family is presently in the United States on furlough.
